Schedule: It takes about two hours to travel each way.

8:00 a.m. – Bus loads in front of Mystic Lake
8:15 p.m. – Bus departs
10:00 a.m. – Arrive at Jeffers Petroglyphs, guided tour
12:00 noon – Depart Jeffers for Lower Sioux Agency
12:45 p.m. – Arrive at Lower Sioux, have lunch
1:30 p.m. – Tour Lower Sioux Agency
3:00 p.m. – Bus returns to Mystic Lake
5:00 p.m. – Arrive at Mystic Lake

Attendees: Approximately 52 people are on the tour. To help you acquaint yourself with your fellow attendees, a roster may be found at the end of this message.

Bus: The bus will load at 8:00 a.m. and leave promptly at 8:15 a.m. The tour bus will leave from the front of the Mystic Lake Casino and Hotel (where the valet parking is). **The bus will not be held for late comers, so please be sure to be on time. Refunds are not provided as ATALM has incurred expenses equal to, if not greater than, the registration fee.**

Food and Beverage: You are permitted to bring beverages and food on the bus, but the bus company requests that you do not leave trash. If you are not taking the bus, and have not already indicated this, please let us know.

Dress: Please wear comfortable shoes as you may be walking over uneven terrain at times. Dress in layers as the weather in October can have significant temperature swings.
